Late Mr. J.N. Dixit (Batch 1952)

Late Mr. J.N. Dixit received his B.A. (H)s Degree in Philosophy, Economics and Political Science from the Zakir Husain College

He was 2nd National Security Advisor of India (2004 –2005) and 18th Foreign Secretary of India (1991 –1994)

He was posthumously awarded the Padma Vibhushan for civil service in 2005.

Mr. Haroon Yusuf pursued M.Com. from Zakir Husain Delhi College.

He has served the nation as Minister of Food & Civil Supplies and Industries, Government of Delhi (2008–2013), Minister of Power and Transport, Government of Delhi (2003–2008), Minister of Revenue, Development, Irrigation, Flood Control and Food & Civil Supplies, Government of Delhi (2001–2003). He was elected as member of the Delhi Legislative Assembly (1993–2015)



Late Choudhary Prem Singh (Batch 1952)

Late Choudhary Prem Singh was graduated in science from Zakir Husain Delhi College in 1952. He was elected as MLA, Delhi Legislative Assembly (1993–2013). He also served nation as Councilor, Metropolitan Council of Delhi (1967–1990) and Councilor, Municipal Corporation of Delhi (1958–1967)

He was awarded Padma Shri in 2000, for his services in the fields of ecology and environment.



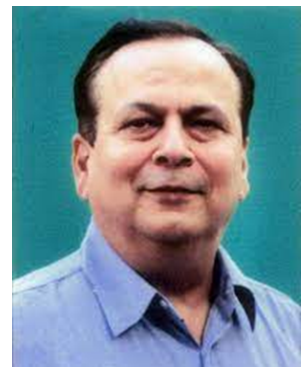
Dr. Harsh Vardhan

He also served as Minister of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (2017 –2019) and Member of the Delhi Legislative Assembly (1993 – 2014)



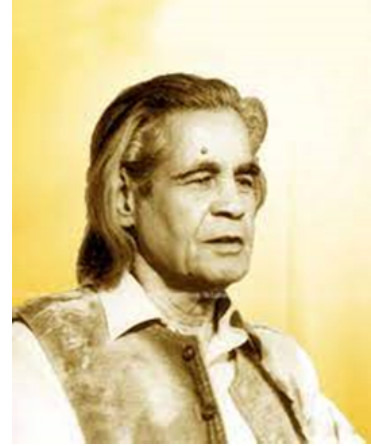
Mr. Pankaj Vohra (Batch 1975)

Late Ali Sardar Jafri (Batch 1938)

His last anthology entitled Sarhad was presented, as a national gift, to then prime minister of Pakistan Nawaz Sharif by then Prime Minister of India Atal Bihari Vajpayee.

He was awarded with Padma Shri in 1967, Jawaharlal Nehru Fellowship in 1971 and Jnanpith Award in 1997.

Late Akhtar ul Iman

Contributed to Hindi cinema significantly as a script writer (dialogue, story and screenplay).

Important movies to which he contributed as a script writer was Kanoon (1960 film), Dharmputra (1961), Gumrah, Waqt, Patther ke Sanam, and Daagh.
