Brief History of the College

The journey of Zakir Husain Delhi college started as the Oriental College for literature, science and art in 1792. In 1824, the institution was renamed Delhi College by the British East India Company's government. By the early twentieth century it became the centre of vibrant scientific and literary intellectual activities that would be referred to as the 'Delhi Renaissance'. The British authorities closed the institution after the 1857 revolt. Between 1864 and 1871 intermediate B.A. and M.A. classes commenced. However the British government transferred the Delhi Oriental College to Lahore in 1877. It was reconstituted as the Anglo-Arabic Intermediate College in 1924. It was affiliated to Delhi University in 1925 and became one of its constituent degree colleges in 1929. The college was attacked and set on fire by mobs following the partition. Somehow, the library and office records were saved. With the support of Dr. Zakir Husain and others, the Delhi College was revived in 1948. In 1975, the college was renamed Dr Zakir Husain to honour his contribution to the college. In 1986, the college campus was shifted to its present location, Jawaharlal Nehru Marg. In 2010 the college was renamed Zakir Husain Delhi College.

Major Activities and Achievements

Zakir Husain Delhi College family actively organised and participated in the academic and cultural events during this period. The college has received an Indian patent for Solar water distiller. Our college has been awarded DBT- Star College Scheme sponsored by Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India. Gandhi Study Circle launched a short term skill enhancement and value-making course in collaboration with Gandhi

Smriti and Darshan Samiti, Union Ministry of Culture. Dr BR Ambedkar Centre launched its

flagship program on reading Ambedkar's "Writings and Speeches Volumes." The NSS unit and

theatre society of our college organised a Nukkad Naatak on the issue of Mental Health at

several places in the University. The theme of the Natak was "Vo Ghav Jo Dikhte Nahi." When

the teachers set the bar high, how can the students be far behind! Our student Subhadip

Mukherjee has been awarded the Consortium for the Humanities and the Arts South-East

England studentship to fund his Ph.D programme at the University of Kent, Canterbury, UK.

Vidhan, B.A (prog) 2nd year student, won a gold medal in Judo in All India Inter University

Championship. Some of our students are also enrolled for free coaching classes for various

competitive exams through the Ministry of Minorities Affairs.
