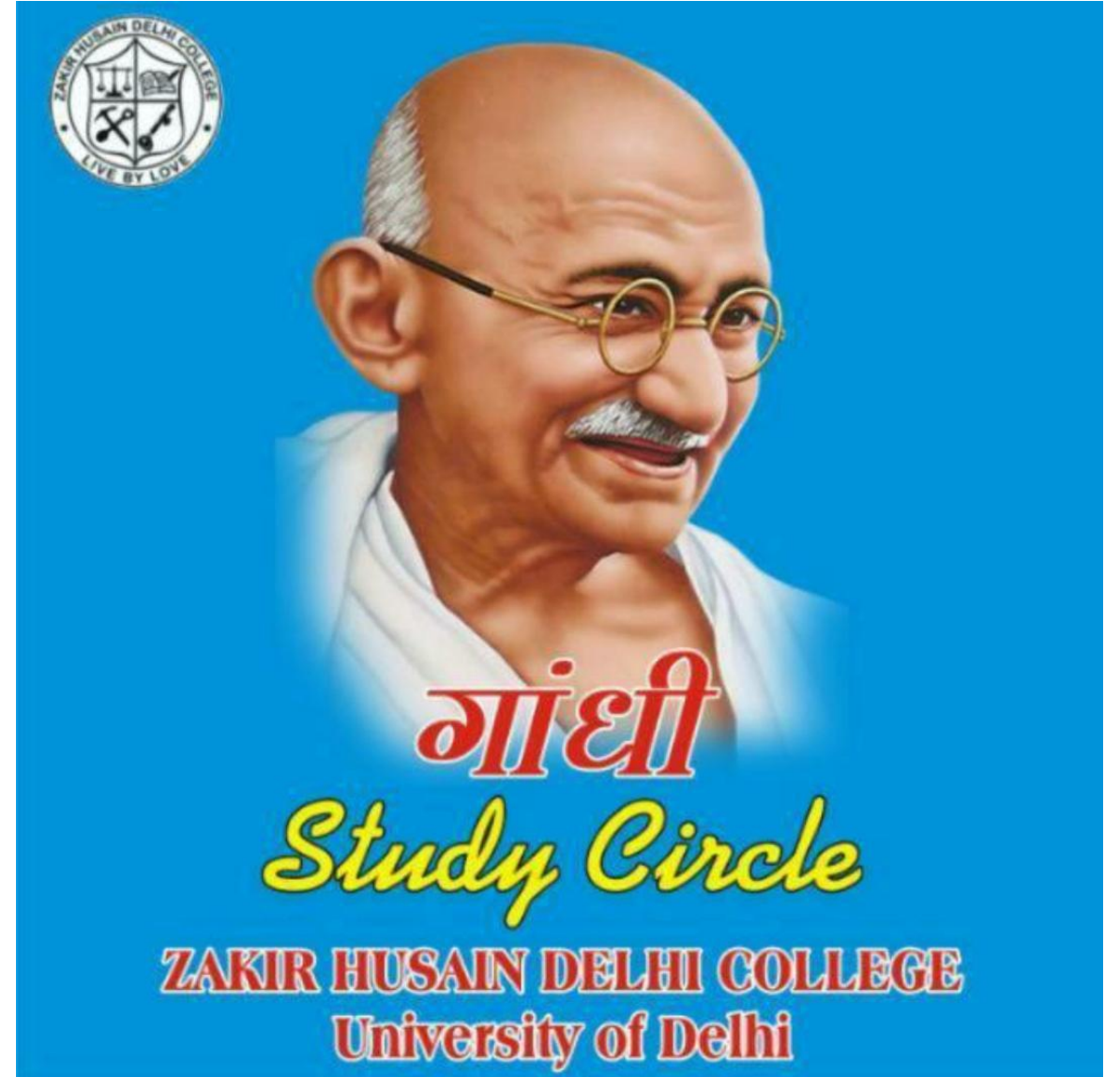
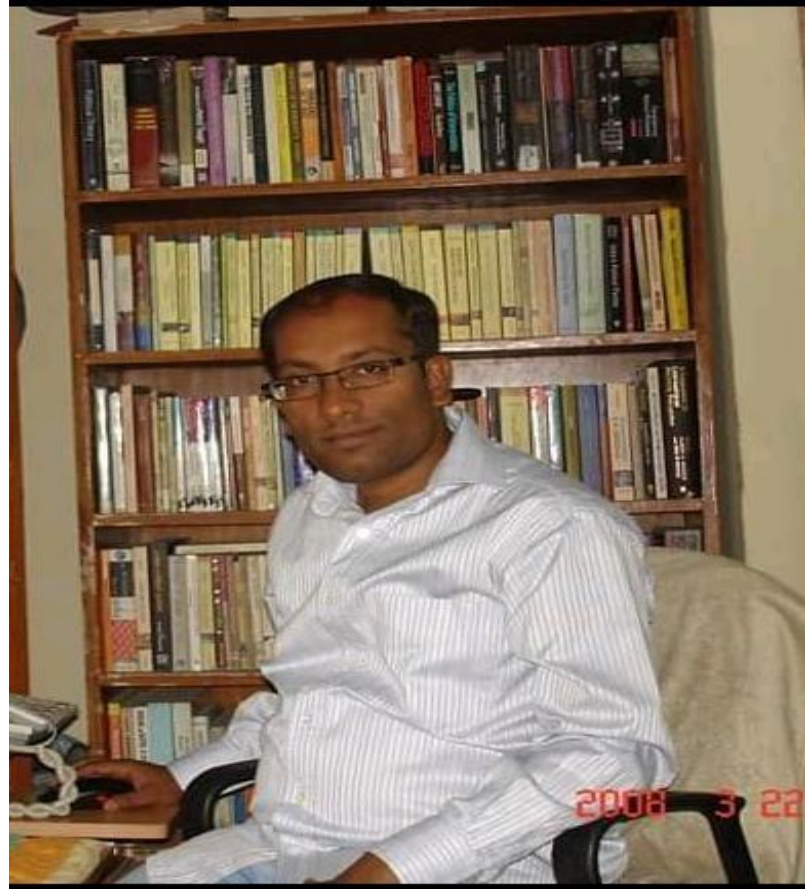

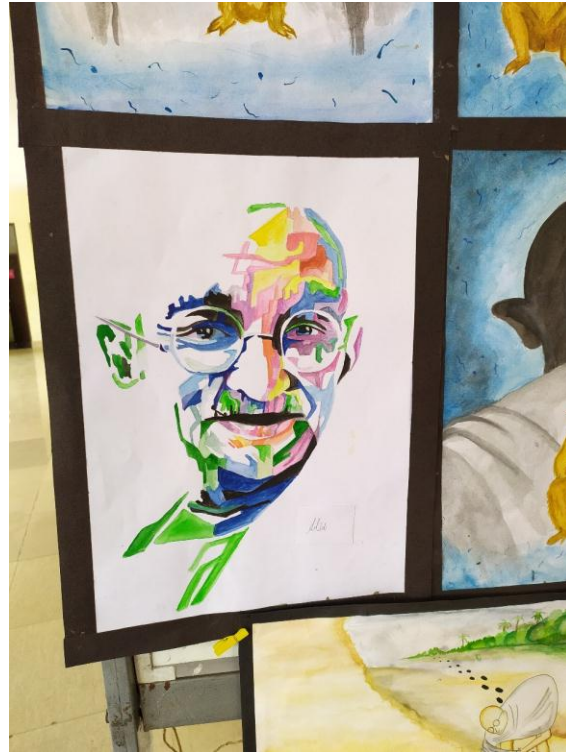
September 17 to September 23, 2019 - Faculty Development Program on "Revisiting Gandhi today: Questions of Caste, Class, Gender, Religion and Environment"

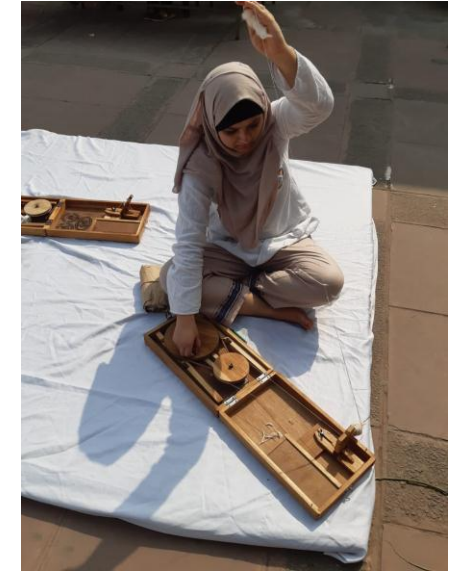
30th January National Gandhi Museum

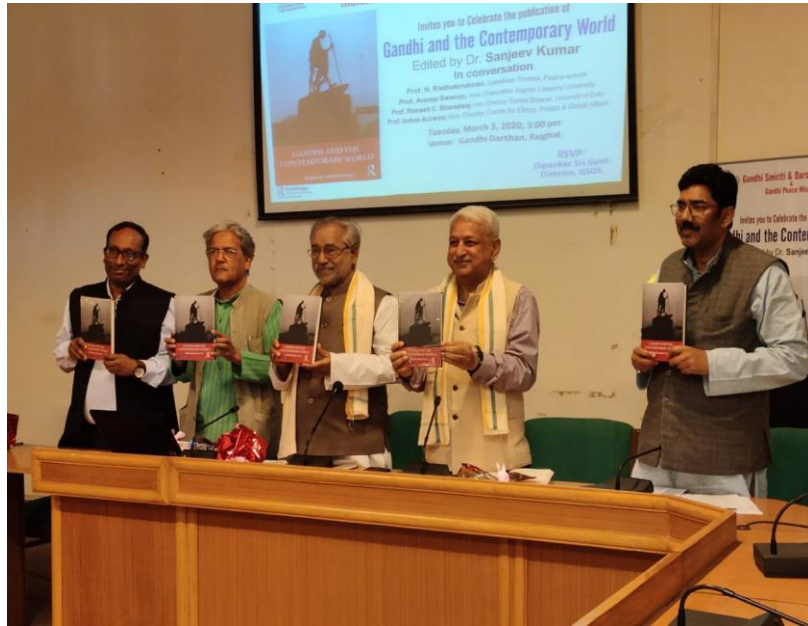


Annual Fest- Innovating Gandhi 2020
