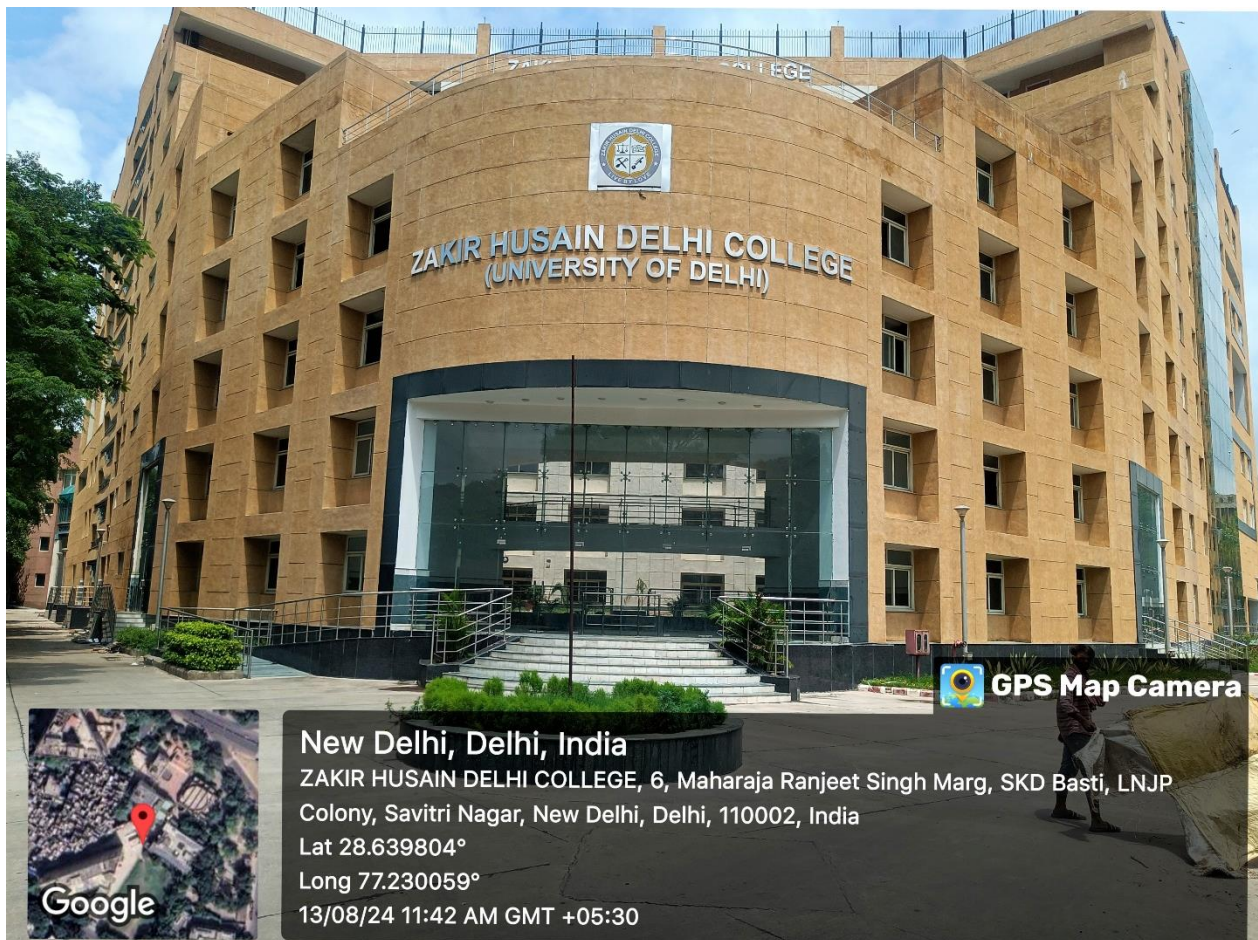

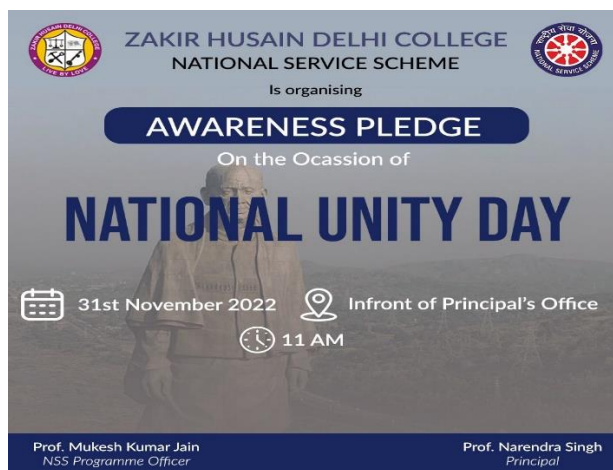
## Cleanliness Drive

## National Unity Day

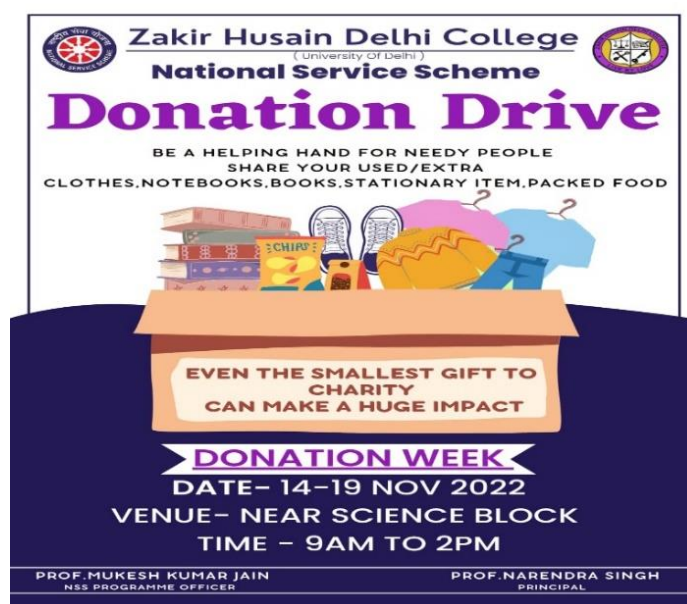
As October 31st was also marked as **National Unity Day**, the NSS Unit of the college organised the Unity Pledge on this occasion.

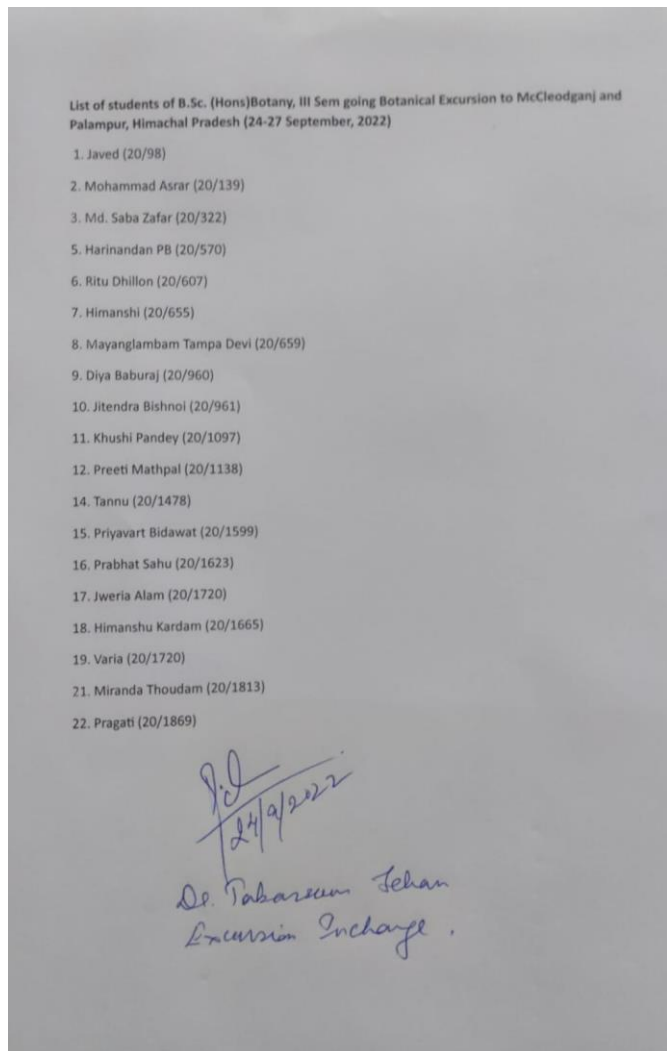

## Department of Botany

1. Department of Botany organised **Botanical Excursion to McLeod Ganj, Himachal Pradesh** for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year students of B.Sc. (H) Botany in between 24-27, Sept, 2022. The accompanied faculty members included Dr. Tabassum Jehan, Dr. Zeeshan ur Rahman and Dr. Ruchi Vir. Students learned about the natural flora of the McLeodganj by a nature walk in the locality. Some relevant plant materials (e.g. *Funaria* and *Pteris*) were collected and brought to the department for class experiments. They also visited two research institutes including Chaudhary Sarwan Kumar Himachal Pradesh Krishi Vishvavidyalaya and CSIR - Institute of Himalayan Bioresource Technology (IHBT). In IHBT, students observed the research facility of laboratory and learned about different techniques such as PCR, autoclave, culturing, etc. Students also visited farms and polyhouses for domestication and development of agrotechnologies of ornamentals, aromatic and medicinal plants and high value crops in the institute.

2. The department organised a **visit to an industry, Yakult Danone India Pvt. Ltd.**, located at Sonipat, Haryana for the third year and first year students of Botany (H) on 15 March, 2023. This visit was a part of their course curriculum for their respective papers, Industrial and Environmental Microbiology, and Microbiology and Plant-Microbe Interaction. During this visit, students were introduced to a presentation on probiotics, their history and relevance in maintaining good health. It was followed by a visit to the production process and packaging process. Students learned about each step of the process and observed different setups of the production including fermenters. They provided information on quality checks and showed the facility of a testing laboratory. Students spent about 1.5 hrs at the factory and also showed interest

and discussed various aspects of the fermentation, production, and safety assessment. Students prepared a report of their visit and submitted it to concerned faculty members.

3. On 22 June 2023, Department of Botany organises a visit to herbarium of Department of Botany, University of Delhi for first year students of B.Sc. Botany (Hons). Dr. Deepika and Dr. Zeeshan accompanied the students for the visit and guided for the preparation. Dr. Shruti Kasana, the Assistant Professor, Department of Botany gave a presentation on the importance of herbarium and presented the key features about the herbarium. Students also visited the herbarium and saw the different plant materials preserved on herbarium sheets.



## Arabic Society

The Arabic Society *Al-Nadi Al-Arabi* organised its fresher's Welcome Programme on 11<sup>th</sup> January 2023, with Prof. Shams Kamal Anjum, BGSBU, as the guest of honour. He delivered the 8<sup>th</sup> Ghaziuddin Khan Lecture and spoke on, "Shamsul Ulama Deputy Nazeer Ahmad: Delhi College's Most Eminent Arabic Poet & Writer", and a book written by him was also released on this occasion. Arabic Handwriting/Calligraphy Completion was organised on 16<sup>th</sup> February 2023, and a Special Lecture was delivered by Dr Suhaib Alam (Dept. of Arabic, JMI) on the topic: "India-Arab Relations: Understanding the Old & New Trajectories". The Mamlukul Ali Lecture was held on 29<sup>th</sup> April 2023, and Professor Naimul Hasan, Head of the Department of Arabic, University of Delhi delivered a lecture on the topic "Use of Information Technology in Learning and Teaching of Arabic Language". Prof. Naimul Hasan also graced the farewell function on 29<sup>th</sup> April 2023, as the guest of honour. Alongside, the department regularly maintains and updates its wall magazine, *Al-Qalam*.

## Aranya- The Nature and Environment Society

Aranya - The Nature and Environment Society initiated a thoughtful initiative and collected Paper and Plastic waste and E-waste from 10th August 2022 to 23rd August 2022. It organised an event on World Rivers Day on 16th September 2022. Three exciting 'What if- A situation-based narration, Poster Making competition and Meme Making competition were held. A book collection drive was held from 6 October to 6 November 2022 and the books were donated to 'Gram Pustakalaya' (mission rural library) which is led by Mr. Ramveer

Tanwar, the library man of India. On 8th February 2023, a speedball-making workshop was organised by the society. It was led by Mr Mohit Relan, the founder of the Yeh Mera Gaon initiative and co-founder of NGO Say Earth. In collaboration with NARGIS- The Botanical Society of Zakir Husain Delhi College, Aranya organised a lecture on "Exploring the Extremes: Journey of a Botanist" on 3rd November 2022. The lecture was delivered by Prof. Dinabandhu Sahoo - the first Indian student to explore Antarctica during 1987-88. The volunteers from Aranya attended Ganga Utsav – The River Festival, which was celebrated on 4th November 2022 under The National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG), Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Ministry of Jal Shakti, at Major Dhyan Chand Stadium in New Delhi in two sessions. A conventional debate competition was held on 14th November 2022 on "Human Extinction Will be a Blessing for Nature". Dhwanik- The Indian Music Society in collaboration with Aranya kickstarted Aaghaz with two amazing performances. A slideshow presentation of a montage of various events organised by the society - Nest-making Workshop, and Pankhudi-the annual fest of Aranya followed by a discussion with anthropologist Mr Anas Khan. On 27th January 2023, the workshop on the cultivation technique of Pleurotus mushroom was organised by Nargis- The Botanical Society of Zakir Husain Delhi College in collaboration with Aranya. The annual fest Pankhudi was organised on the 16th and 17th of February 2023. Various competitions like the singing competition, Mandala Art, Nukkad Natak competition, Paperless Artistry Competition, and COP-ZHDC commenced on the agenda- deliberation on eco-capitalism to achieve sustainable development goals. Young environmentalist Palakh Khanna, Founder/CEO of Break the Ice organization, a World Record Holder, Regional Officer for the Asia Pacific and an active environmentalist working towards Sustainable Development Goals delivered a lecture at the event. A pottery stall was also organized. The final event was a Stand-up Comedy Competition in which humour was inculcated in advocacy to bring environmental issues to the limelight.



## **Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM)**

For Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM) - an initiative of the Government of India's Ministry of Education, to celebrate 75 years of our Independence - inter-college singing, slogan writing, and essay writing competitions were organised in July with participation from 150 students across 20 colleges of the University of Delhi. The Arts and Culture Society organised intra-college collage and rangoli competitions. On 8th August 2022, World University Service's Delhi University chapter, in collaboration with Saksham Indraprastha, organised an eye check-up camp at the college auditorium foyer with more than 180 participants. On 13<sup>th</sup> August 2022, as part of the Har Ghar Tiranga programme, a 'Tiranga Yatra', facilitated by the NSS Unit of the college was held with flag hoisting by Principal Prof. Narendra Singh along with honourable Chief Guest Sh. Suresh Jain, National Organising Secretary, Bharat Vikas Parishad. The library committee organised a week-long book exhibition displaying books on India's Independence struggle. The Garden and Greening committee planted three trees, Neem, Bargad and Peepal called "Triveni" on the college campus. The Arts and Culture Society organised a Cultural Programme. The lighting of the lamp with Sanskrit Shlokas and Saraswati Vandana was followed by felicitation of the Guest of Honour Prof. Sushma Yadav, Prof. Anil Aneja, Chairman of Governing Body, and Prof. Amit Bardhan, Treasurer, Governing Body. This was followed by the college

Taranaana, and a Bharatnatyam and Kathak-Jugalabandi by the student members of Nrityathi, the classical dance society. The music society, Dhwanik presented patriotic group songs and Aman, the theatre society staged a play titled, "Gagan Damama Bajiyo" on the life of Shaheed Bhagat Singh. The members of the Western dance society Dhanak performed a group dance commemorating the contribution of Captain Vikram Batra, the Paramvir chakra awardee, during the 1999 Kargil war. Suchitra, the fine arts society exhibited the hues of patriotism through their painting exhibition. A selfie-point-Har Ghar Tiranga also witnessed participation. The students and staff gathered in the college and recounted the stories that they had heard of the partition and what some of their forefathers had to undergo during the partition. A two-minute silence was observed, followed by a Silent March in the college to offer respect to the lives that were lost in 1947.

- **World University Service- Delhi University Chapter** organised an eye check-up camp in collaboration with Saksham Inderprastha at the foyer of Salman Ghani Auditorium on the premises of the college from 9.30 am to 1.30 pm. More than 180 non-teaching, teaching staff members and students participated in this camp. Post-Covid, the eye problems were increasing as the screen time grew tremendously. This eye check-up camp provided eye testing both automated and manually. The participants were informed about the importance of eye donation and encouraged to donate eyes. Those donated eyes were given the certificates of donors. Those who were suffering from long-sightedness were given free spectacles, as well. The organising secretary of Saksham Inderprastha Shri Devendra Kumar Ji, also announced that if any participant needed any surgery related to glaucoma or otherwise would be treated for free. Prof. Narendra Singh, the Principal, thanked the WUS-DUC and Saksham Inderprastha for their support in organising such a camp for the first time in this college. Mr Khem Chand, representing Saksham, promised to organise more camps in future. Five student volunteers from [B.Sc\(Hons\) Maths III Year](#) helped manage the entire camp, including registration and guiding participants for eye donation. The camp concluded with a vote of thanks by Prof. Gurpreet Singh Tuteja

to all the participants, Saksham Inderprastha, paramedics and medical staff of Delhi Bharat Vikas Foundation for organising such a helpful camp.



## **Bengali Literary Society**

On the 23<sup>rd</sup> of April, 2022, the students and teachers of the Bengali Literary Society held the 9<sup>th</sup> Gopa Dey Memorial (online) on a very interesting topic, *Terracotta Temples of Bengal and India*. The Speakers invited were Prof. Shreela Basu, Visva-Bharati and the Chair was Prof. Gopa Datta, the Ex-Vice-chancellor of Gour-Banga University. Rabindra Divas' was celebrated on the occasion of Rabindranath Tagore's 16<sup>th</sup> Birth Anniversary on this same day. An essay writing competition was held on the 11<sup>th</sup> of August 2022, by the students of the Bengali Literary Society and the theme was 'Svadhinatar Pachattar Bachhor' (75 years of Independence). In the month of May, the students of the previous two Final years (2019-20, 2020-21) and Final year students of 2021-22 were invited to a farewell function by the Department, and a very colourful cultural program was organized by the junior students. This year the Bengali Literary Society organised its Fresher's Welcome on the 9<sup>th</sup> of February where songs, recitations, dances and speeches were performed by and for the incoming students. The 10<sup>th</sup> Gopa Dey Memorial Lecture was held on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2023 on the topic: *Agni Puja in Indus-valley Civilization*. Slides were presented of the Puja seats from excavation sites and relics were shown physically to show the difference between the Agni-worship cult of the Vedic period and the Harappan people. The Speaker invited was Mr. Sandipani Bhattacharya who is the Deputy Director of Amity Group of Institutions. Prof. Amitava Chakraborty, Dean, of Art's Faculty and Head of the MIL&LS Department chaired the session. The farewell function was held on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2023 with colourful festivities.

## **B. R. Ambedkar Centre**

On 24th May 2022 and 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2022, the centre organised two Student Seminars Methodology and Ethics of Writing workshops. Three review sessions were also held. The resource person of these was Dr Santhosh J., Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science. On 30th June 2022, a Student Seminar on 'Castes in India: their Mechanism, Genesis and Development' and 'Annihilation of Caste' was organised. Dr Harish Wankhede, Assistant Professor, Centre for Political Studies, School of Social Sciences, Jawaharlal Nehru University, was the keynote speaker of the seminar. Students sang 'Saheb Mere Bhim Rao' followed by a video presentation by the media cell of the Centre. The centre celebrated Constitution Day on 25<sup>th</sup> November by organising a lecture delivered by Dr Arvind Kumar of Jamia Milia Islamia. A photography competition, quiz competition, and an orientation programme for a new batch of students were also held. The Centre organised a special lecture on 31<sup>st</sup> January 2023, with Dr Jadumani Mahand, Assistant Professor of Political Science, Jindal Law School, OP Jindal Global University, speaking on 'Ambedkar's Constitutionalism as a Democratic Theory'. The second edition of the inter-college annual fest, 'Manuski was organised, and it started with a speech by Dr Santhosh J., followed by a debate competition. A quiz competition on Babasaheb and Phule was organised in collaboration with Quintessence, the Quiz Society. Apart from these events, the centre organises regular reading and discussion sessions on Dr B.R. Ambedkar.

## **Career Counseling and Placement Cell**

This academic year the Placement Cell of Zakir Husain Delhi College was able to bring in Placement and internship opportunities from more than 60 companies. We were successfully able to conduct a Job Fair which took place for two consecutive days. Students from all over the University were welcomed to this Job fair. With the help of 30 very hardworking members of the Cell, we were also able to conduct various seminars which added to the skills and knowledge of the students. Some of the details regarding the seminars and the companies are given below:

### **Seminar with TIME**

We organized a career Counselling event to help students understand their options after graduation. The event focused on CAT, GMAT, and government exams. An experienced professional in the education and corporate sectors was the guest speaker. He shared his journey, from graduating from Sri Venkateswara College to getting an MBA from the Indian Institute of Planning and Management. The event focused on discussing career paths after graduation, including pursuing further education through CAT or GMAT, finding government jobs, or exploring opportunities in the corporate world. Students had the chance to ask questions during the Q&A session, where Mr. Poddar and T.I.M.E representatives provided guidance and advice.

## Seminar with Internshala

We organized a seminar in collaboration with Internshala. The topic of the seminar was “How to prepare for your dream job and internships”. The seminar was held in AV Room on 19 Jan 2023 between 10:45 AM to 12:00 PM in which Students from all courses and all years were invited, in which the speaker taught students how to prepare resumes and common mistakes students make in their CVs in a very interesting manner. ### Annual Job Fair February

The Career Counseling and Placement Cell of Zakir Husain Delhi campus started off the placement season for the class of 2023 with a job fair held on the campus grounds on the 8th and 9th of February. Under the direction of Principal Professor Narendra Singh and convenor Dr. Dhiraj Kumar Singh, the students of the cell could attract 40+ companies who hired students from all backgrounds for various responsibilities. Within two days, more than 120 students got job placement offers. The college welcomed Shri Manoj Tiwari ji as the chief guest to the Job Fair's launching event. Manoj Tiwari is an important role in Indian cinema as well as an active member of parliament. Sir acknowledged the audience with his dignified presence and talked about his journey to motivate and inspire the students. On the first day, 30 companies honored our campus with their presence. Renowned organizations such as Internshala, Profusion Konsulting, Vision Educom, Next IAS, TATA AIA, Byjus, You Got Brains, and many others interviewed students for jobs and internships.

The students were thrilled since they were dressed formally and engaged with the companies of their choice. It was a pleasure to observe that all of the company stalls were occupied at all times by students. The first day was a success, with many first and second-year students landing internships and final-year students completing their interview rounds and being placed. The first day recorded an annual package ranging from 3.5 LPA to 7.5 LPA, which encouraged more students to take part in interviews and placement interactions. Day 2 began with the same enthusiasm among members of the placement cell and recruiters. Along with



Piramal Finance, Byjus, SITR Labs, DU Today, RNF Tech, Connecting Galaxy, Asian Online, TATA Strive, and Nexjob, all of these companies joined us on this particular day. The student's passion and vigour were the same as they had been on day 1. For their pre-placement meetings, students joined in with organizations like Byjus and RNF Tech to discuss their preferred employment roles and their organization as a whole. Some businesses, such as Piramal Finance, Asian Online, and RNF Tech, had group discussions and in-person interviews in the college itself. Some of them additionally handed out offer letters to the deserving students there. On Day 2, shortlisted candidates received an average package of 5.5 LPA. ## History Society-Udanta

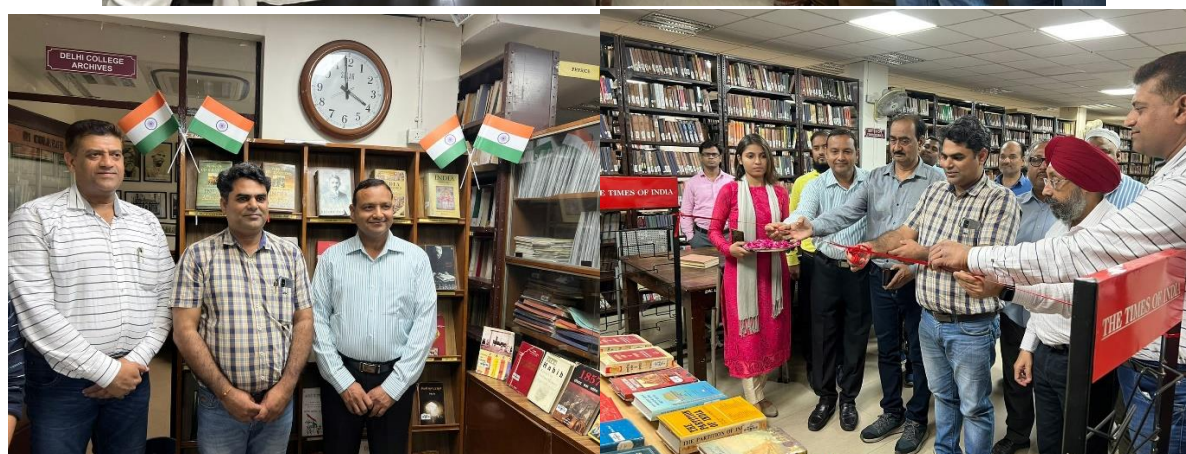
