



dplyr, authored primarily by Hadley Wickham was launched in 2014. The package is described as "a grammar of data manipulation, providing a consistent set of verbs (functions) that help you solve the most common data manipulation challenges. The set of functions are designed to enable data frame manipulation in an intuitive, user-friendly way. Data analysts typically use dplyr in order to transform existing datasets into a format better suited for some particular type of analysis, or data visualization. The entire course will be delivered online. Classes shall be held every day for one hour including practical from March 10-12, 2022 either on Google Meet or Zoom or MS Team. Being practical based course, candidates must have their working reliable laptops in every online class.
