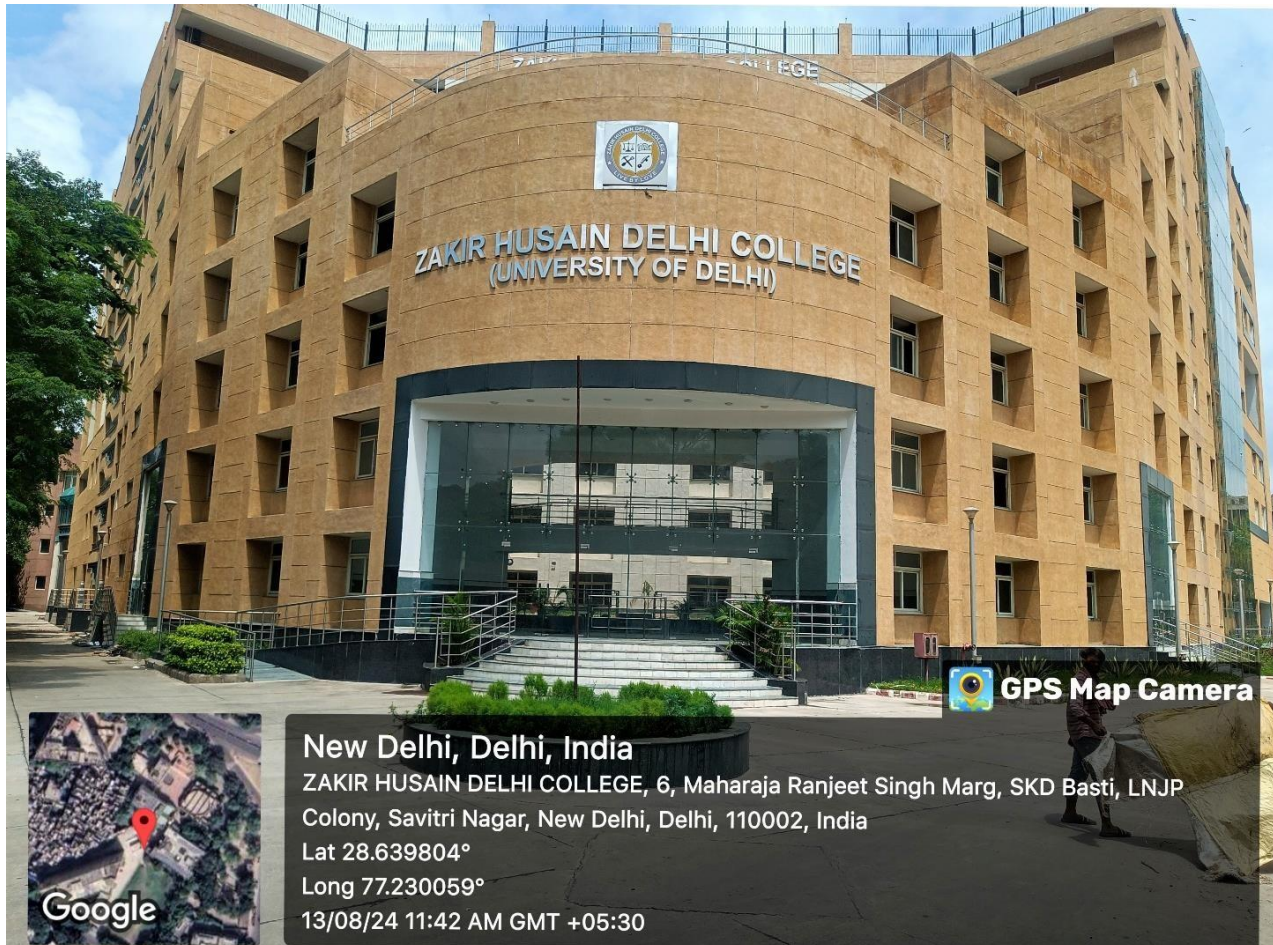

**Mucormycosis**

At present active cases of Mucormycosis in India are approximately 28000.

**Mucormycosis**- a rare fungal disease with a high mortality rate, is the latest challenge being faced by India. This is commonly referred to as “black fungus”. Hence it is extremely important to understand the pathogenicity of the fungus. According to the revised taxonomy, fungi causing mucormycosis are classified in the new phylum Mucoromycota order Mucorales. The most common fungus that cause mucormycosis is *Rhizopus arrhizus* however, other fungi causing it may include *Mucor* species, *Cunninghamella bertholletia*, *Apophysomyces elegans*, *Absidia* species, *Saksenaea* species, *Rhizomucor pusillus*, *Entomophthora* species, *Conidiobolus* species, and *Basidiobolus* species. Approximately half of all mucormycosis cases are caused by *Rhizopus* spp. many other cause similar clinical syndromes.

Mucorales are saprophytic and ubiquitous in nature. They grow on organic substrates, including bread, decaying fruits, vegetable matter, crop debris, soil, compost piles, and even on animal excreta. The mycelium is non-septate and responsible for rapid growth. The fungus attacks deep tissues by means of ingestion or inhalation of spores. This is an opportunistic fungal invasion which is of a great concern in COVID-19 patients.

## FACILITIES

**Reading Halls:** The College Library has two fully air-conditioned reading halls with a total seating capacity of 200. It also houses two teachers' enclosures having collective seating capacity of 20 besides one Enabling Unit for differently abled users of the Library.

**Book Bank:** The College Library houses a Book Bank, which is the largest in the whole Delhi University, with a rich collection of around 12000 books with yearly addition of around 500 books covering all the disciplines taught in the College. The books are procured in the Book Bank strictly keeping in view the demand of the students. It renders services to the students by providing them with the text books (*Maximum 04*) of their choice for the whole academic session. The students are required to apply for getting this facility as and when notified. To ensure transparency in distribution, books are issued on first come first served basis. Students are required to return these books before the commencement of their examinations to get Clearance/No Dues from the library. However, if the students want to retain the books till the examinations are over, they are required to deposit their educational documents as security.

**Delhi College Archives:** It is housed in the College Library. It was inaugurated by Prof. Sabyasachi Bhattacharya, Chairman, Indian Council of Historical Research on 18<sup>th</sup> February 2008. Delhi College Archives contain a large number of files and books related to the College history and the significant developments in higher education in Delhi and North India from 1823 onwards. Besides original writings by the teachers and alumni of the College in Urdu, Persian and English, textbooks prepared and used during the 19<sup>th</sup> century for instruction in mathematics, history, geography, literature etc. are also a part of its collection. It also contains important secondary sources and books related to the Delhi College and the intellectual ferment in the Delhi region during the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> centuries.

**Property Counter:** The Library offers the facility of property counter to its users. Users are required to deposit their Bags (excluding valuable items such as money, passport, credit/debit cards/mobile phones etc.) with the property counter attendant before entering into the library.

**Special Facilities offered by the Library to the Differently Abled Persons:** There is a ramp at the entrance of the College Library for the purpose of facilitating the access of physically challenged users in the library. VH and PH users are not required to wait in the queue for issue/return of the books. The Library staffs address the requirements of all such users on priority basis. There is one computer connected with Lex Scanner (*which converts text into voice*) and headphone meant for the use of VH students. The Library subscribes to 3 magazines in Braille format for the use of such users. If required, the Library staff helps visually challenged users by converting their print material into voice material using Lex Scanner provided by the EOC of the University of Delhi. Delhi University Braille Library Membership is also provided to the visually challenged students where they are provided with all their reading material both in Braille as well as audio format.

**Photocopy:** The Library provides photocopy facility to its users within the library premises. The users are charged Re. 1/= per photocopy.

**User Orientation and Awareness:** All the newly enrolled students are made aware about the various facilities provided by the College Library every year during Induction/Orientation Programme organized on the very first day of the start of the new academic session. The students are also helped and trained in searching the books in the College Library by the library staff.

**Assistance in Searching Databases:** The staffs of Multimedia and e-Resource Lab. assist the users in searching the databases available to the College through DULS via the website of the University of Delhi.

**In-house/Remote Access to e-Resources:** The users access this facility through DULS and University of Delhi website on their laptops, smart phones and the computers installed in the Multimedia and e-Resource Lab. of the College Library.

**Download and Printing:** These facilities are available to the College fraternity in the Multimedia and e-Resource Lab. inside the College Library. The users can download documents and other information from the various databases and electronic journals provided to the College through DULS and even take out prints as per their needs and requirements.

**Reference:** College Library provides access to all reference collections including encyclopedias, yearbooks, dictionaries, directories, competition books etc.

**New Arrival Display Service:** Books newly added to the library are displayed on the New Arrival Display Showcase before they are released for loan besides posting of information about newly acquired books and starting of new facilities and services on the Facebook page of the Library.



## LIBRARY RULES

**Library Timings:** The College Library remains open throughout the year except on Sundays and University holidays. On all working days the Library is open to the users from 08:30 AM to 08:30 PM. The Library timings during the vacations are notified at the beginning of each vacation.

**Membership:** The membership of the College Library is open for all the bonafide students, teachers and non-teaching staff of the College. Since the College Library is running on a fully automated mode since the Academic Year 2017, the whole College fraternity has been provided with electronic membership having their unique membership ID as mentioned on their respective Identity Cards. Category-wise entitlements of the books are as under:

**Admission to the College Library:** While entering the Library, the user has to show his/her valid Identity Card at the Entrance Gate and also has to sign on a Register kept there in token of agreement to conform to the Rules and Regulations of the Library. Private books and personal belongings are not allowed inside the Library. The students may keep their bags and belongings (except valuable items such as money, passport, credit/debit cards/mobile phones, laptops etc.) in the Property Counter outside the Library and get a token issued from there, which has to be surrendered to the Property Counter staff at the time of leaving the Library for getting back the belongings deposited there. In the event of loss of the token, the user has to pay a fine of Rs. 50/=.

**Issue System:** A user has to present valid Identity Card for the issuance of the desired book on loan. The period of loan is 15 days.

**Loss of Books:** The user is responsible for the safe custody of all the books issued to him/her. In the event of loss of a book, the student is required to replace the book either of the same edition or the recent edition to the Library. If the lost book is not available in the physical market then the user is required to purchase the same through online mode for the purpose of its replacement in the Library.

**Conditions of Loan:** Reference Books, Newspapers, Magazines, Journals, Previous Year Question Papers, Syllabus, and other reference materials kept in the College Library will not be issued to anyone under any circumstances. However, the user is allowed to consult them inside the College Library and may also get photocopies of their desired pages.

At the time of issuance of a book before leaving the counter, the user must satisfy himself/herself that the book issued to him/her is in sound condition. If the books is damaged or torn out, the user should bring the same to the notice of the counter staff for getting another copy of the book, if available. At the time of return of the book, if any damage or injury to the books is noticed, the member shall be deemed responsible for the same and will be required to replace the book either of the same edition or the recent edition to the Library.

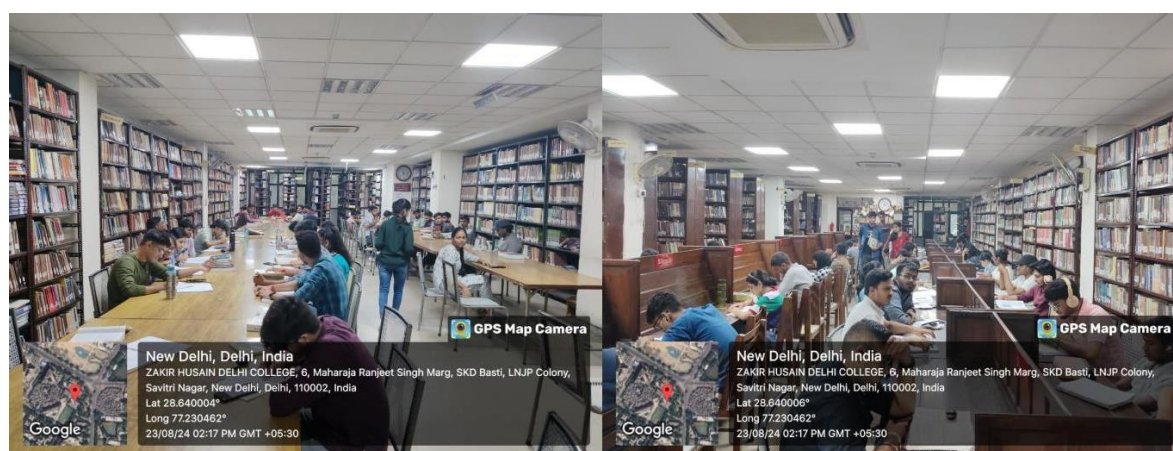
**Reservation of Books:** The books which are in great demand and which generally remain under issue can be reserved by the user at the Main Counter as well as Circulation Counter.

**Overdue Fine:** All the books issued on loan have to be returned by the users on or before the Due Date stamped on the Date Slip of the book. In case of late returning of the book, an Overdue Fine @ Re. 1/= per day per book will be levied on the user.

**Open Access System:** The Library is running on the Open Access System wherein the users have direct access to the shelves and freedom to browse through the books arranged therein. However, the users are advised not to replace the books in the shelves themselves but to let them remained on the reading table to avoid wrong shelving or displacement of the books.

**Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC):** There are three Computer Systems kept in the OPAC area dedicated for the purpose of searching of the desired books using Online Public Access Catalogue. In case of any difficulty faced by the users in searching their required books, they may contact any of the Library staffs for assistance.

**Atmosphere of Study:** As the Library is a place for individual study, it is necessary to maintain quiet, calm and dignified atmosphere inside it in order to let all the users study without causing disturbance of any sort to the fellow users. Talking and discussion inside the Library are strictly prohibited.

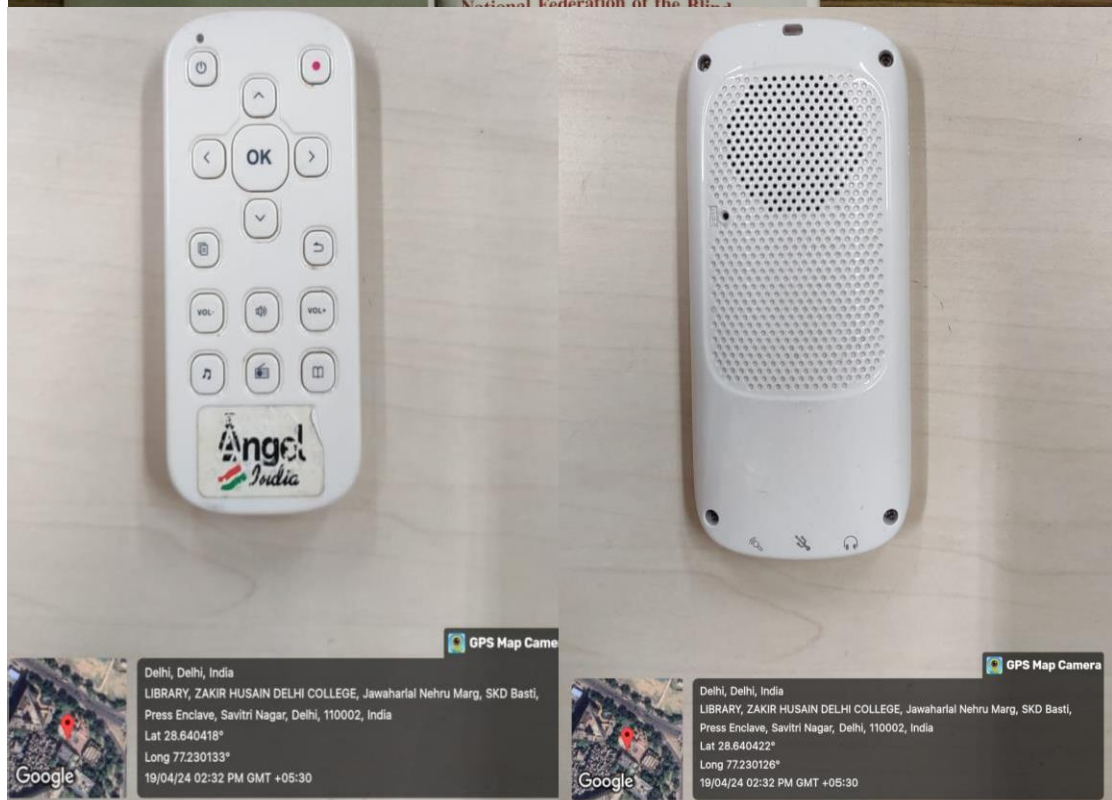

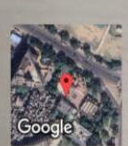
