

Tribals do not trade. A seminar on the topic "Tribal Literature: History and Tradition" was organized on 09 April 2024 by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell of 'Zakir Husain Delhi College' and Arunodaya: Hindi Sahitya Sabha. On this occasion, Prof. Snehlata Negi of the Hindi Department of Delhi University was present as the keynote speaker. The principal of the college, Prof. Narendra Singh welcomed Prof. Negi by presenting a plant to him. After that, Prof. Negi presented his lecture on the topic "Tribal Literature: History and Tradition". Professor Negi, while speaking, discussed the tribal history and tradition in detail and said that the tribals do not trade their land and conscience.

Discussing the meaning and idea of the term 'tribal' in sociology, politics, history and literature, Prof. Negi also mentioned the folk traditions, history and valorous tales of the tribal community. While presenting the concept of tribal literature, he also clarified the difference between oral and written forms. He substantiated his points by mentioning the writings of Rangeya Raghav, Maitreyi Pushpa, Ranendra and Veer Bharat Talwar. Giving a brief introduction about the movements of Birsa Munda, Adivasi Stri Vidroh etc. in oral traditions, he took his point further and said that the tribal society emerged in literature through social traditions.



Under Rule 10 (4) of the Official Language Rules 1976, it has been notified that more than 80 percent of the employees of the Employees State Insurance Corporation have working knowledge of Hindi. In the end, the honorable keynote speaker talked to the students about exploring various possibilities to earn a livelihood in the field of official language Hindi and concluded his talk by discussing the interrelationship between language and culture.

Departmental Lecture on "Dalit Literature in Urdu" 30th October 2023

A departmental lecture titled "Dalit Literature in Urdu" was organized under the auspices of Bazm Adab, Department of Urdu, Zakir Hussain Delhi College. Dr. Mithun Kumar, Department of Urdu, University of Delhi attended the lecture as an orator. The program was presided over by Dr. Alam Shams, Teacher-in-Charge, Department of Urdu and Dr. Hriday Bhanu Pratap, President, Bazm Adab.

First of all, Dr. Hriday Bhanu Pratap, while introducing Dr. Mithun Kumar, unveiled the aspect that Mithun Kumar sir's distinction and specialty is that he has a strong grip on Dalit literature. He has done his Ph.D research work in the field of Dalit literature. After this, Dr. Alam Shams welcomed Mithun Kumar with a bouquet. At the same time, Dr. Muhammad Moinuddin presented a bouquet to Dr. Alam Shams, Teacher-in-Charge, Department of Urdu and felicitated him.

Dr. Mithun Kumar, in his sermon, tried to link the theme to the time when the Aryans arrived in India and competed with the dalit community, the original inhabitants of the country. Later, one after another, other nations came and later the arrival of Muslims started. All these nations had a profound impact on Dalit society, but there was no difference in the social and economic conditions of Dalits. Yes, but the attitude and behaviour of The Muslims certainly served as a wound to the Dalits. Despite all this,



Further, Dr. Mithun Kumar highlighted his position and said that Urdu literature was not written according to what should have been written about Dalits. Also, the manner in which dalit issues, hardships and exploitation should have been presented was not advocated. They are not represented anywhere in classical literature, be it narrative or mythology. Later, when fiction and novels came into existence, the conditions and problems of Dalits were also given space. In particular, he also highlighted the scale, themes and principles of Dalit literature.

In his presidential address, Dr. Alam Shams, Teacher-in-Charge, Department of Urdu stressed on equality and said that racial discrimination was not the fault of religion, but it was the result of the mentality of the people in power and this system continued for centuries. And said that this lecture will definitely open new avenues of thinking for the students. He then thanked all the guests. On this occasion, colleagues Dr. Muhammad Moinuddin, Dr. Shahana Maryam, Dr. Muhammad Mustmir and Dr. Imran Chaudhry (from the Department of Persian) were also present.







making it an engaging and interactive session. The event was a significant



Post-Screening Discussion:





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
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Lecture on Demand for reservation and the women's movement in India

The Department of Psychology organized a one-day Mental Health Drive for all the students of Zakir Husain Delhi College (Morning), on the 15th of March, 2024. This student-led event, facilitated by the Psychology Society, 'Psychedelics' under the aegis of IQAC and Vikasit Bharat Abhiyan@2047, demonstrates the department's commitment to fostering a healthier society, which believes in taking preventive measures and participating willingly in screening camps and seek professional help, if needed.

Students from all the courses were encouraged to come ahead and participate in this event. With the tagline, 'Know Yourself', the participants were given the choice to opt for any two tests from an array of 7 different psychometric tests — namely, Beck Depression Inventory (BDI), Beck Anxiety Inventory (BAI), UCLA Loneliness Scale, General Health Questionnaire (GHQ), Alcohol Use Disorders Identification Test (AUDIT), Ten Item Personality Inventory (TIPI), and Trait Emotional Intelligence Question Short Form (TEIQue SF).

The event witnessed a turnover of more than 140 students. A total of 217 copies of different psychometric tests were administered.

The event, while up-keeping the ethics of psychological testing, provided the opportunity for all the students to get to know about themselves. The interested students were briefed about the tests

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informed decisions, they were provided with an Informed Consent form. They were assessed using scientifically developed, reliable and valid psychometric tools, in comfortable environmental conditions. Once they were done filling in their respective responses, they were debriefed about the test. Their responses were then scored, interpreted and informed to them via mail while maintaining confidentiality. In cases with alarming results during this screening drive, they were advised to consider seeking professional help.

Conclusion:





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About the Event

Omics approach at various levels is the key to understand the flow of genetic information from DNA to RNA to protein. It has multifaceted applications in understanding molecular basis of acclimation, stress response, disease response, etc. Omics is now an integral tool in basic research as well as for understanding and development of novel molecular diagnostics. These technologies have the generic goal to reveal the mystery of living system by recognising the components in totality and to analyse the interaction among these components. 

Online National Workshop on Bioinformatics Resources, Tools, and its Applications



Refresher course on Digital upskilling


15th -17th February 2022

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
Poster of the refresher's course on Digital Upskilling workshop

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Refresher course on Lab Techniques



In Botany Department laboratories, experiments are carried out towards various fields of Botany like biochemistry, cell biology, ecology, embryology, anatomy etc. as per the course curriculum of under graduate programs. Lab staff are responsible for managing chemicals, equipment and preparing solutions commonly used in the experiments. Since the strike of COVID 19 in our country, all came to a standstill. College premises were closed for the students and teachers. The labs were closed down too in whatever condition they were. Labs had been closed for 700 days. This long period without students and their practical classes, has caused a kind of knowledge erosion which needs to be restored at the earliest. The aim of this five-day Refresher course was to refresh and impart The Lab staff with traditional and newer methods and techniques of scientific experiments. 



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Conference on Water Sustainability Conservation, Policy, Ethics and Science

21st -22st January 2020

In past several years India has experienced several environmental disasters and water scarcity problems. Recent water crisis in cities like Chennai, Bengaluru, Mumbai and Shimla highlights seriousness of the problems. These issues have given rise to conflicts among multiple stake holders at various levels. Global community agrees that such problems can be controlled and conditions can be improved if we efficiently implement Sustainable Developmental Goals number 6,9,11 and 12. These goals target clean water and sanitation; industry, innovation and infrastructure; sustainable cities and communities; responsible consumption and production respectively. Achieving these targets will require support from all stakeholders including government to participation of people and especially the young students whose future is at stake due to environmental issues. Support of policy makers, academia, financial and global institution will play a crucial role in reducing above stated problems. These institutions can help by creating awareness among the public and enhancing capacity building. With this objective in mind need was felt to organize the conference to educate and deliberate in presence of students together with various stakeholders. The conference was well attended by all sections of society and deliberations were indeed fruitful. There was tremendous participation of students from undergraduate as well as post graduate students. A lot of research scholars also put up posters and oral presentations where they showed their efforts how they are contributing to the society and the environment through their scientific findings. The conference provided an opportunity to researchers to discuss the problems being faced in conducting research in t COORDINATOR IQAC

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water. Solutions were offered by scientists and delegates from Jal board. Even the scientific community was enlightened by the ground reality of the environmental degradations by the activists who fought the real battle. The invited speakers were the real-life fighters to conserve the environment, be it river or forest they faced the challenges posed by the government and the society to preserve the pristine conditions of the nature. Dr. Rajendra Singh's success fight to rejuvenate the dead rivers of Rajasthan and uninterrupted flow of river Ganga motivated the students, researchers and teachers of the Zakir Hussain College. He explained how dam formation and major river projects altered the sediment flow of the Ganga River system which reduced the sediment flow necessary for nutrient dynamics and recharge of ground water. Maiti movement of Mr. Kalyan Singh Rawat has educated the Uttarakhand people and sparked the sense of social responsibility to keep the forest alive. Dr. Faiyaz Ahmad Khudsar's work to restore the ecosystem of Yamuna Biodiversity Park and Mr. Manoj Kumar Misra's efforts to keep Yamuna River clean were inspiring and motivating for students as well as faculties of colleges. Dr Sushmita Baskar threw light on educating people through education and resource material so that Education will result in the application of new technology: using low flush toilets, lowflow showerheads, push and sensor taps, faucet aerators and using of laundry programs requiring less water. Education can induce a change in behaviours like reducing irrigation of lawns, irrigation during late evenings when the evaporation rates are lower or use recycled water for car washing, watering lawns and installing rainwater harvesting systems. Professor Dinesh Mohan's talk on water treatment strategies were interesting and compelled delegates to start thinking on the lines of water conservation and recycling water by various treatment methods in order to use it for several non-drinking purposes. Professor Dinabandhu valedictory talk introduced the delegates about water resources on earth beyond rivers, ponds and wetlands. He took the delegates through a journey to Antarctica where a biology research 1 NEAR

He also talked about moving research lab in water bodies of Manipur. His talk was immensely enjoyed.
